APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST - VERY IMPORTANT PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

APPLICATION LINK

ELIGIBILITY – You must reside in McHenry County

• Up to seven \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to current graduating High School seniors who reside in McHenry County in recognition of their abilities and contributions to the fine arts. The award will be based on demonstrated ability in the arts and completed application requirements.

TALENT SHOWCASE AT WOODSTOCK OPERA HOUSE – APRIL 6, 2023

- Scholarship recipients must be available to perform in the Annual Woodstock Fine Arts Association Talent Showcase, scheduled for Thursday, April 6, 2023 at the Woodstock Opera House.
- Scholarship recipients will present one submission at the Talent Showcase on April 6, 2023 that will be selected by the WFAA Scholarship Committee from your application submissions.

GATHER YOUR MATERIALS – DEADLINE FEBRUARY 21, 2023 at midnight

- Applications and all documents, detailed in this checklist, must be received on or before the APPLICATION DEADLINE of Tuesday, February 21, 2023 at midnight.
- This application form must be completed and submitted in one sitting. There is no save function; you will NOT be able to come back to it later.
- Prepare your application materials as detailed in the Application Requirements Checklist BEFORE completing the online application. Copy and paste your longer responses into the Application form.
- No partially completed applications will be accepted.
- No scanned applications will be accepted.
- Application is VOID if the form is altered.
- Scholarship Award Winners will be notified on or before Monday, March 6, 2023.

 - You may add this information to the video or your Essay .pdf.

Visual Arts Categories (see above)

- Artist Statement: Describe your medium, process and inspiration for the series or each piece.
- Submit a Powerpoint with Artist Statement (first slide) and SIX images documenting your best work (one slide for each piece).
- Theatrical Costume / Set Design: Please describe your contribution to the production.

Creative Writing Category

• Please submit one .pdf with THREE writing samples.

MORE INFORMATION ABOUT DOCUMENTATION and LINKS

DOCUMENTATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Be sure to check the Choose Your Category of Art section for the required number and type (video or Powerpoint or .pdf) of documentation to submit.
- Please submit Performance quality videos only.

LINK INSTRUCTIONS:

- Please upload your samples to a sharing service (e.g., YouTube, Dropbox, Google Drive) that allows you to create a public link. Paste these links into the form.
- Please ensure the links you provide are functioning EVEN WHEN YOU ARE LOGGED OUT OF THE SHARING SERVICES.
- Please do not submit links that are locked and require a password.

ADDITIONAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- <u>TWO</u> letters of recommendation: <u>One</u> letter of recommendation needs to be from a school counselor or instructor, and <u>one</u> from an individual who is familiar with your involvement in the arts. Neither letter of recommendation can be from someone to whom you are related. These letters are required to be on letterhead with the email of the author. Letters should be emailed to <u>scholarship@woodstockfinearts.org</u> with the applicant's name in subject line.
- Transcripts must be submitted via email by your counselor or school administration to: <u>scholarship@woodstockfinearts.org</u>. Please put applicant's name in subject line.

- Essay: 500 words maximum. Please describe how you will use your talent and interest in the arts in your future. Please email a .pdf with the following to <u>scholarship@woodstockfinearts.org</u>
 - Performing Arts: Add the title, composer, accompanist and/or playright or author of the original work to your Essay .pdf.
